# What is 4-H?

4-H is the largest out-of-school youth development program in the world that teaches young people leadership, citizenship and life skills.

4-H members participate in fun, hands-on learning activities supported by the latest research of land grant universities. These activities are focused on the areas of healthy living, citizenship, science, engineering and technology.

Youth can experience 4-H by becoming a member of a 4-H club, attending a 4-H camp, or by joining school-based or afterschool 4-H programs.

# How Do I Join?

All youth ages 5-18 years old are invited to join! It's as easy as deciding you want to join and completing the 4-H enrollment form and medical release form found on our website.

There are several ways to be involved in 4-H. Most 4-H clubs meet about once a month for 1-2 hours. Meetings usually include a short business portion, an educational activity and recreation or refreshments. Membership in a club allows youth to meet new friends, enjoy new learning experiences and grow as a person.

**Create Your Own Club:** All it takes is five youth and a leader. Use your imagination in creating your very own club name. Hold meetings once a month and design your own educational program. Contact your 4-H Agent to learn how to get started.
